The purpose of these guidelines is to make sure that plan members (employees) receive enough information to make informed investment decisions. Economic Commentary - Q4 2020

The global economy continues to be seriously affected by the spread of COVID-19. A resurgence in many parts of the world has resulted in a temporary deterioration of the global economic outlook because of the measures implemented to curb the pandemic. However, the beginning of vaccination campaigns in many countries has contributed to advances on the main global stock markets.

In Canada, the steep rise in oil prices and the strong growth of the financial sector helped boost the stock market, which posted growth of 8.7% during the quarter¹. Like many of the other central banks, the Bank of Canada maintained very favourable financing conditions to help the economy get through the pandemic and foster guick post-COVID growth.

In the United States, the US presidential election created its share of uncertainty. Joe Biden's victory should lead to many changes in economic, health and environmental policy. On the equity side, the technology and finance sectors contributed to the 8.8% growth of the MSCI USA Index in Canadian dollars (total return). The Canadian dollar appreciated against the US dollar, reducing returns for US dollar-denominated assets.

The level of volatility on the global financial markets remains relatively high due to uncertainty tied to the COVID-19 pandemic.


The fourth quarter capped a tumultuous 2020. After an excellent 2019, the financial markets were keeping pace at the beginning of 2020, until the COVID-19 pandemic hit. After posting sharp retreats in February and March, the stock markets made a strong comeback thanks to government recovery programs, central bank interventions and the reopening of economies. The markets then fluctuated in line with the evolution of the pandemic and progress in the development and distribution of the various vaccines.

All in all, 2020 was a positive year for the main stock and bond markets. As such, the US stock markets posted growth of 28.6% for the year, fuelled by the strong gains in technology stocks². The Canadian stock market was slowed down by the energy sector and grew 3.5% in 2020³. On the bond side, the central banks' highly accommodative monetary policies put downward pressure on key rates, including in Canada, where this context contributed to the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index's 8.7% return for the year.

Melodia Funds - Performance Review

- All five Melodia Funds recorded positive absolute returns during the fourth quarter of 2020. On a relative basis, all Melodia Funds outperformed their respective benchmarks during the quarter.
- Over the last twelve months, all Melodia Funds generated positive returns and all funds outperformed their respective benchmarks. Their added value ranged between 1.74% and 3.59%.
- Regarding the fixed income component, all bond funds generated positive returns in the fourth quarter of 2020.

 Returns varied between 1.14% (Desjardins Canadian Bond Fund) and 6.16% (Desjardins Floating Rate Income Fund).
- As for the equity component, all equity funds posted positive returns. The fund that contributed the most to performance was the Desjardins Overseas Equity Growth Fund (18.29%). The Desjardins Overseas Equity Fund contributed the least (7.70%).

Governance

Desjardins Governance Process - The Four P's

Our meticulous monitoring program is done by a dedicated team of investment experts and includes rigorous processes to select and monitor fund managers.

When selecting fund managers, we examine the objectives and constraints that managers will face and then seek managers most likely to successfully meet all requirements. It is imperative that their risk-return strategies correspond twe investment policies, guidelines and overall needs of our plan sponsors with principles in line with ours.

A combination of factors will be taken into consideration such as the manager's innovative and proven philosophy under various circumstances, adherence to the portfolio's investment policy / strategies and long-term performance. As a result, we only select top-quality fund managers with complementary management styles to offer a well-balanced, diversified selection of funds.

Every quarter, an analysis is conducted on each of the funds offered on our platform. Four main criteria, the four P's, are used: People, Process, Portfolio and Performance.

This analysis allows us to determine our level of comfort with each of the funds. Funds that do not meet one or more of these criteria are placed on a watch list, which means they are monitored more closely and a specific correction plan is put in place.

Executive Summary - Q4 2020

At this time, two underlying mandate composing the Melodia Funds and two funds from the \dot{A} la carte funds are being monitored closely:

- The Desjardins Canadian Equity Value Fund, which is an underlying of the Melodia Funds, is being monitored due to overall performance below expectations.
- The Desjardins Enhanced Bond Fund, which is an underlying of the Melodia Funds and offered À la carte, is being monitored due to overall performance below expectations.
- The Desjardins Global Small Cap Equity, which is an underlying of the Melodia Funds and offered À la carte, is being monitored due to overall performance below expectations.
- The Desjardins Global Equity Dividend fund (Epoch), which is offered À la carte, is being monitored due to certain changes to the investment process.

All the other underlying mandates of the Melodia Funds and the À la carte funds adequately meet our four governance criteria.

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
